## **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

This 42-hour training program is designed for students already familiar with the basics of Spanish vocabulary, pronunciation and grammar. By the end of this course, students will have developed the following skills:



- Learn vocabulary related to a range of different cultural, current affairs and news topics.
